Our tutors are **peer**, or **student**, tutors. This means they are students just like you are! All are current or former NWACC students, and many have worked their way up from algebra to beyond calculus. This means that they understand what it is like to be a new student trying to figure college out, and so you can feel comfortable approaching them with any questions or issues you have. We offer tutoring in Bentonville and at the Washington County Center.

Our Tutoring Center focuses on **math** and **science**. Some other courses may be covered, but these are dependent on the courses our tutors have taken and have earned an A or B in; these may include those in the social sciences, arts and humanities, foreign languages, business, and computer information. Currently, our area does not handle writing or reading tutoring as we have the Writing Center and Academic Literacy Center (BH 1003) on campus to assist with those subjects. Have questions? ACADEMIC STANDING AND SUCCESS PLANNER

To remain in **good standing**—with the college and with financial aid—you need to maintain a **2.0 GPA or higher and pass 67% of the courses you officially attempt**. If your teacher feels you are at-risk, he/she may raise a flag on your account in Success Planner and send you an email to alert you to the issue. It's important that you talk with your instructor regarding what the issue is and work together to resolve it. Additionally, when you do well, you may get a kudo in recognition of your good work! Finally, you can also use Success Planner to schedule an appointment with your adviser to discuss these issues, talk about your goals, and plan for future semesters. Success Planner is accessed in My NWACC Connection on the left-hand side.
